### Bip Holland B.V. The Simpsons Power Stick (48)

These medium sized stickers can be found on a Power Stick sweet. The stick is sealed in a clear packet so you can collect the set without having to buy duplication. The stickers are numbered, but the numbering system is different from the Power Dips issue. Also the background colour is changed to the standard Simpsons Red and Yellow. Sticker size 40 x 55, and dated 2005.

### Quaker Oats Sugar Puffs 'Bee Movie' (1)

A single competition card was included with the packet of cereal. The DreamWorks film Bee Movie was the theme of the issue. There is a picture of the Honey Monster on the front of the card with the caption "Are you gonna Bee Lucky?" The reverse carries the entry details. Card size 84 x 53, dated 2007.



### Beacon Confectionery Ltd. 'Me to You' (12)

Contained within the two bar chocolate package is one of twelve cards. The wrappers on the chocolate depict a bear with one half of a valentine heart.

There are six different edge colours to the cards and two of

each to make up the twelve card set. Each card has a picture of a bear, and a caption such as 'Snuggle up'. Card size 115 x 106, and dated 2007.



### Windel GmbH & Co.KG 'Easter Bunnies' (1)

Although there are three differently designed chocolate wrappers there is only one design of card. The theme on the wrappers is the same as that you see on the card, a shame they only produced one card. The cards are sealed within a plastic wallet and this is dated 2008. The card once removed does not have a date. The card has a message area on the reverse for your loved one. Card size 169 x 89.



### Panini Magazines 'Marvel Characters 3D Action Cards' (3)

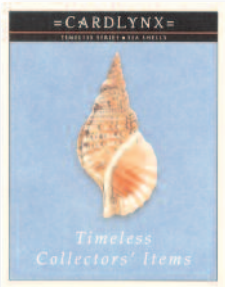
Issued within the 7th May 08 edition of Spectacular Spider-Man comic is a free gift of cards. These are enclosed in a plastic cover on the front of a collectable Spider-Man card. accompanying instruction sheet for the assembly of each character. 3-D action card size 90 x 60, unnumbered but dated 2008.



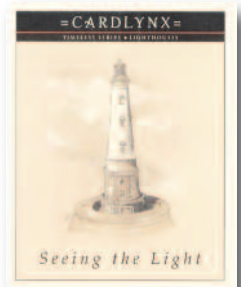
**Baco Consumer Products Ltd.**
