SFX SC-FI Magazine 2000AD Playing Cards (54)

Issued with the August 2008 magazine was an exclusive set of playing cards. Each card depicts a different character from the movie with the character's name, date and movie title to the left of the picture. Card size 86 x 56.



Zed Candy Ltd. Jawbreaker Reeky Planet Tattoos (?)

Within the four Jawbreaker pack can be found one of these Reeky Planet tattoos. There is no indication on the packet how many there are in the set.

Tattoo size 33 x 20 undated and unnumbered when removed from the wrapper which has a BB date of 24/06/11.



Weetabix Ltd. Kung Fu Panda (24) + (1)

Packed inside the Weetos cereal can be found a set of 10 game cards along with the single instruction card. The cards are issued in pairs making 48 to collect, but there are only 24 different pictures. The characters are from the recent hit movie of the same name. The game is based on the children's memory game. That is: all the pairs of cards are placed face down; you can only turn over two cards at a time; if you make a pair you keep them; you take it in turns and whoever wins the most pairs wins the game.

Cards are 6 sided and measure 42 x 42 unnumbered but dated 2008. Instruction card size 89 x 50. There are also four differently designed cereal boxes to collect.



Tesco Wall-E Stickers (8)

These stickers can be found within the Tesco Disney Easy Peelers Clementines red string bag. Some of the pictures are very similar, so look carefully when you collect your set. The stickers depict the character from the recent movie. The modern day Womble clearing up all the rubbish. Size 39 x 39 unnumbered and undated.

stickers (8)**

Similar to the Wall-E stickers issue but with characters from Winnie the Pooh stories. Size 39 x 39 unnumbered and undated.



Doctor Who Adventures Magazine No. 69 (91)

Included within the sealed plastic wrapper of issue 69 for 19 - 25 June are 91 stickers. The sticker designs include one sheet of padded stickers, two sheets of silver backed stickers and one sheet on a A4 peel off page. All the stickers depict characters and scenes from the catalogue of Dr. Who. Padded sheet size 119 x 144, Foil sheet size 'Planet of THE OOD' 209 x 150, Foil sheet size 'For the Glory of Sontar!' 248 x 158 dated 2008, Peel of sheet size 330 x 248. None of the sheets are numbered.

Bookmarks (6)**

Inside each of the specially design packs can be found one of six bookmarks to collect. The bookmarks are stuck to the inside of the pack but are easily removed without damage to the bookmark. The pack shows all six characters to collect, the pack however has the same back designs as the previous issue. Card size 80 x 32 with a logo TM date of 2004.

Moves' (16) (x4) = (64)**

Given free with every McDonald's Happy Meal is an Album and a set of Panini stickers. The stickers are sealed in a typical Panini packet numbered 1 and 2. The sixteen stickers depict stars of today and ballet training moves, and complete the album when all peeled off and stuck in. Size 64 x 53 dated 2008. Four Mini albums and corresponding stickers sets to collect.



Morrisons Supermarkets. 3D Jigsaw Puzzle (7)

Given away free at the Café at Morrisons is an activity pack. The gifts were given with the purchase of a children's meal. Included within the pack is one of seven jigsaw puzzles each depicting one of the Characters from the BEE Movie. The puzzles are mounted on an attractive card which also shows scenes from the movie. On the reverse of the card are pictures of the seven to collect. There is also a chance to win one of fifty BEE movie DVD's. Card size 228 x 151 Dated Bee Movie TM 2007 but unnumbered.

**Kent Bubble Gum 'Toy Box', Comic sheets (?)
Box Designs (?)**

Within the ToyBox wrapper there is a comic sheet, highest number seen 140, a box with brick type designs for building a castle, house etc. and a series of collectable toys with descriptive papers. Some of the boxes have a picture of a suggested building for you to build. All the boxes are numbered. Comic sheet size 73 x 69 undated, Box size 45 x 48 undated.



Mr Lucky Bags Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull

Inserted in the bag with the toys sweets etc. is a very nice sheet of stickers. The stickers show a small size advertising poster used for the film and character photos. Also included is a movie magazine with puzzles to solve etc. and an adventure journal with sketches etc. from the movie. There is also a set of four pogs with photos of the movie stars that could be peeled off and stuck on sheets for your album. Pog picture size 24mm circ. Dated 2008, it is not known how many are in the series.

Burger King Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull

There are eight different toys given away free with the children's meal at the restaurants. One of them takes the form of a code book with decoder card. With the front advert sheet it makes a very nice collectable. Size of code book 75 x 100, undated, size of decoder card 61 x 58, undated. Advert sheet closed 101 x 76 dated 2008 Lucas Films.
