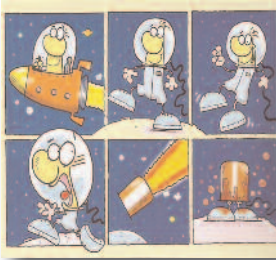


# New Issues

There are 5 cards within each pack and an Instruction Sheet on how to play the Storyline game. Card size 84 x 60, Instruction Sheet size open 252 x 88.



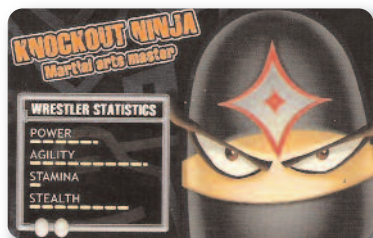
### Panini Camp Rock (192)

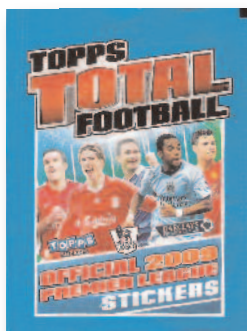
### Panini Camp Rock Trading Cards (124)
