## Tesco Stores Limited Disney Pixar 'Toy Story and Beyond' (?)

The cartoon character stickers were packed with peaches or pears. The fruit was packed in trays and the clear envelope containing three stickers was packed inside. Combinations of characters have been found within the clear envelopes, 24 different have been seen to date.

Sticker size 50 x 40, undated and unnumbered.

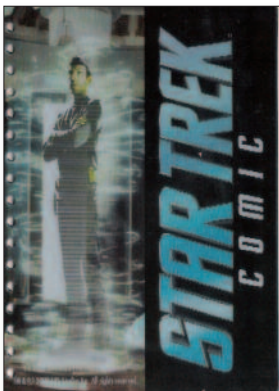
## Brandlines Limited The Dark Knight (?)

The collectable sticker can be found on the inside of the chocolate bar wrapper. There are four differently designed wrappers; the pictures are taken from the recent hit movie. The highest sticker seen to date is no.48, but it's not known if this is the number in this attractive sticker set. Sticker size 41 x 23, numbered top left and dated (s08).



## Titan Publishing Star Trek Comic 'Notebook Cover' (1)

The notebook was issued on the front cover of issue number 3 August '09. It displays Spock in the transporter ready to be beamed, (probably into trouble) somewhere in the galaxy. Notebook cover size 119 x 99, dated 2009.



## Marks & Spencer Ltd. Gift Card '125 Years Anniversary' (1)

The card illustrates the shop in Seven Sisters Road 1914 that helped to get the business rolling. The shop was originally known as a Bazaar; with a large sign above the entrance stating 'Admission Free'. The gift card part can be detached and you can use the remainder as a greetings card. Card size complete 149 x 125.

## Royal Pigeon Racing Association

The card in the shape of a pigeon was issued to enlist the help of the public. On the reverse of the card it asks if you find a racing pigeon to ring their number and care for it until it can be repatriated. It also asks if you would quote the number on the pigeons ring attached to its leg. Card size 110 x 94, undated.

The four large cards depicting games and puzzles are the printed stiffener cards within the packet. Along with the cards and the attractive outer wrapper there are five mini wrappers to collect. The characters are depicted on the outside and the mini wrappers. Card size 159 x 119, numbered top right but undated.

**Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince (7 days of gifts)**

Starting with the issue on Saturday July 11th the first gift was a Preview DVD No.1 of the movie. In the Sunday mirror the gift was a sticker album produced by Panini, Monday – Videogame Demo Disc, Tuesday – Preview DVD No.2, Wednesday – 2, 3-D cards as depicted and a large poster depicting the London battle scene, Thursday – Fridge Magnet card with the four main characters, Friday – USB Flash Memory card send away for free offer. 3-D Card size 159 x 113, unnumbered and undated.

A very attractively produced set of cards showing head and shoulder portraits with biographical details on the reverse. Card size 90 x 65, numbered centre back but undated.

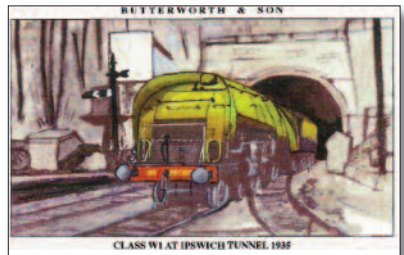


**JF Sporting Collectibles
