- Item 103. Add new issuer. **El Siboney**, Cuba. Unnumbered.
- Item 114. Add new issuer. **Murai**. Nos. 10, 12, 17, 19 and 20 seen.
- Item 139. Add 2 new subjects under “Shinbashi”, making 47 now known:
Miss Fugiye, Miss Yen.
- Item 142. See also H.123.
Add new issuer. **Castro & Montoya**, Colombia. Flower name omitted.
Manuel Reyes Veliz, Ecuador. Backs in black. Trade issuer.
- Item 152. Add (20. A Busby (R profile)).
A Busby (F ½ L) - Murai
Esperanza – Murai
Add “M” to 36, 41 and 102
- Item 153-I. Add Lucie Gerard – F, seated in rocking chair
Edith Grane – F, at bottom of steps, white full length dress, holding flowers
- Item 153 – II Add 48th subject: Isabella Irving- B, one hand to hair at R/shoulder.

49th subject: Lillian Russell – ¾, seated taking tea.

Item 156-A-2. Beauties “Plums”. Add Murai horizontal back in gold – “Home Cigarettes”. Since so few subjects in the Murai edition are similar to any of the other issuers it is now considered that the series are not connected.

Item 156 B-1. Beauties “HUMPS”. There are two printings in the Godfrey Phillips and three in the Hudden issues – see H. 222.

Item 156-B-2. Pretty Girl Series “RASH”. Add: Back G1 in brown. No. 15
Back G4 in blue. Nos. 4/6, 15/17 seen.

Item 156-C. Add to the cards appearing in the Ritchie playing card sets – No. 31.

Add to Beauties ROBRI subjects known – 2, 3, 6, 7, 11.

Another card known similar to a second Bukhsh Ellahie card.

No. 34 is the subject “Odalisque” from World’s Smokers, Item 166.

 - (a) back with Eastern characters at base in (a) blue (b) shades of red-brown (2 styles).
 - (b) back in red without Eastern characters at base.
3. Front with gold border. Size 56 x 33. Back in olive green. See RB118 Fig. 162-2-c.

Item 168. probably all issued.

Item 169. Murai printings. Most now seen, probably all issued.

Item 170. Ritchie edition: Inscribed at top "Smoke Puritan Plug Cut" or "Smoke Old Chum Smoking Tobacco", firm's name at base. Unnd. One specimen is rubber-stamped with name of "F. Beland, Tobacconists, Quebec".

50. Lucy Gerard – ¾, coat with high collar, black hat with white flowers.

136. Marguerite Urquhart – HS, head resting on arms, no hat.
